Good Morning!

What is the most pressing crisis of our day? There are many from which to choose. Richard Edelman, President and CEO of a leading global communications firm, says "The United States is enduring an unprecedented crisis of trust." Vice Admiral Vivek H. Murthy, former Surgeon General of the United States has identified loneliness as the most lethal health crisis in America today. Our president, Donald Trump, believes that the current border crisis rises to the level of a national emergency.

A crisis that doesn't get as much publicity is one the church is especially equipped to address. I'm speaking of a crisis of biblical

literacy. Acts 2:42 describes the early church as being devoted to the apostles' teachings. Does this describe your church?

I'm encouraged that Sunday School attendance in Indiana Yearly Meeting has increased in recent years! There are IYM congregations with strong Sunday Schools, and others that struggle. Since the systematic teaching of scripture to both children and adults is more and more crucial, here are a few questions for you to consider.

Is the Bible systematically taught in your congregation? Do you have

Sunday School teachers who are committed to teaching the Word of God? How are teachers selected and trained? Would your Sunday School class be a good place to invite an unchurched friend?

It's easy to fall into comfortable patterns and lose sight of the real purpose for gathering in a Sunday School. When was the last time your Sunday School was evaluated? Is the environment of your Sunday School conducive for discipleship and spiritual growth? If not, what are you going to do about it?
